For proper cleaning of your cast polymer product **use only non-abrasive** cleaners. Any cleaner that you would use on glass is suitable for cultured marble. Any abrasive cleaner will eventually dull the finish and can eventually remove the glossy finish. Do not use strong chemicals such as bleach or ammonia. To maintain the high lustre of your cast polymer product we recommend an occasional coat of automotive wax or Gel-Gloss. The surface of cast polymer, although hard, can be scratched with hard or sharp objects. Most small surface scratches can be removed by applying a fine automotive rubbing compound and buffing to a high lustre. Deeper scratches may require sanding with 600 grit sandpaper followed by rubbing compound and polishing to restore the finish. Deep scratches or chips may require professional repair.

The surface of cast polymer, although hard, can be scratched with hard or sharp objects. Most small surface scratches can be removed by applying a fine automotive rubbing compound and buffing to a high luster. Deeper scratches may require sanding with 600-grit sandpaper followed by rubbing compound and machine polishing to restore the finish. Deep scratches or chips may require professional repair.

KELERI CARE AND USE INSTRUCTIONS

Keleri tops are non-porous polyester solid surface composition with the color going all the way through. It is the solid surface composition that allows Keleri vanity tops to be machined and cut for a custom fit.

Most normal household cleaners can be used on Keleri tops. Strong industrial chemicals such as paint solvents and drain cleaners are NOT recommended. For hard to remove water stains and residues a powdered abrasive cleaner such as Bar-Keeper's Friend, Bon-Ami, Ajax or Comet is recommended. Do NOT use steel wool or metal scouring pads on your Keleri vanity top.

Light scratches and gouges can be removed by using a red "scotch-brite" pad . Deeper scratches may require using fine grit sandpaper followed by a red "scotch-brite" pad.

Solid surface cleaners and polishes are available on the market that can protect the finish and repel water.

Do not use your solid surface countertop as a cutting board. While stain resistant to household chemicals it is not stain "proof". Wipe up stains immediately.

Do not place hot pans on the surface, this results in uneven heating of the countertop and can lead to further damage.
